Since the 1970s he has exhibited his works around the world and has participated at major international events in China, Germany and Italy.

His works are presented at the most important private and permanent collections, including the Museum of Memoria y Tolerancia in Mexico City and the Vatican Museums.

In the early 1990s he was one of the youngest Latin American artists to participate in auctions at Christie's and Sotheby's in New York.

In 2019, the Florence Biennale in Italy awarded him the **Lorenzo the Magnificent** Prize for Sculptural Career. Other artists recognized with this award are Christo, David Hockney, Anish Kapoor and Marina Abrámovich.

He currently lives and works in Pietrasanta, Italy.

The *Lapidarium* project is presented at different parts of the world, exhibiting its large-scale sculptures in installations that keep enlarging until reaching 100 unique pieces to be presented at the closing ceremony.

The horses reflect the historical illness of the Quadriga and are witnesses of its own journey: migration, search of asylum and immigration.

In addition to collecting the ancient heritage of distant cultures, these sculptures honor the work of the great Renaissance Master, Leonardo Da Vinci.
